# State of School Address/ Updates - Principal Mashburn

- Kindergarten is switching from matrix grading to number grading. There has not been direction from the district yet, but when there is Mr. Mashburn will give an update.
- Rebuild Buildings that needed to be demolished are demolished. PE building
  has been placed, working on interiors, electricity. Restrooms and 4 classrooms
  still scheduled to be rebuilt. Still looking at a December completion.
- Dismissal is still running longer than wanted. This will get better once the rebuild is complete.
- All teachers at Sinclair are fully certified.
