Fundraising - Kim Ludlow

- The PTO has received an estimate to do one large sunshade over the main playground, one over the rockwall playground, and one over the kinder playground. The estimate is \$179,000.
- This can be installed over the summer if the money can be raised at the auction.
- To supplement the auction funds, there will be a capital campaign project starting in October to sell brick pavers to be installed at the new mural wall.

- There is also a company that wants to donate \$30,000 after the storm destruction to the school. This money will be earmarked for technology at the request of the donor.
- The PTO will need to discuss and prioritize needs if we are unable to raise the \$179,000. This would likely impact enrichment programs like Ready Grow Garden and WITS next year. We will need to discuss this impact at future PTO meetings.
- There will also be a second estimate for the sunshades.
