Recovery update - Kim Ludlow

- Fifth grade buildings are here with plumbing and electricity all hooked up. Some of the decking is not in yet and the inside still needs some work. The 4 plex which was previously music, wraparound, book room, and dyslexia/speech seem to be mostly ready to go. Counselor's room is not in yet. It is in North Carolina. The hope is that the punch list will be done by end of January and classes can shift into the buildings by early to mid February. When the time comes, the PTO will put out a call to parents to help transition the classes back into the new classrooms. This will likely be done on a Saturday so there is no disruption to classes.
- The playground will still need some work done to it, but all spring events will happen this year. We are waiting to see what HISD will pay for vs what the PTO will need to pay for in terms of mulching and filling in holes that were created by construction.

Budget Report/ Updates - Grant Yip

- Updated treasurer reports were passed out for review.
- Finances are good. Money is still coming in via corporate matches for Boosterthon.
- We are working on creating a new form for purchase requests.
- AET fund \$30,000 donated to the school. This can only be used for school supplies. We have purchased 15 Chromebooks and 4 Clever Touches so far.
 More Clever Touches will be purchased once the fifth grade buildings are ready.
